

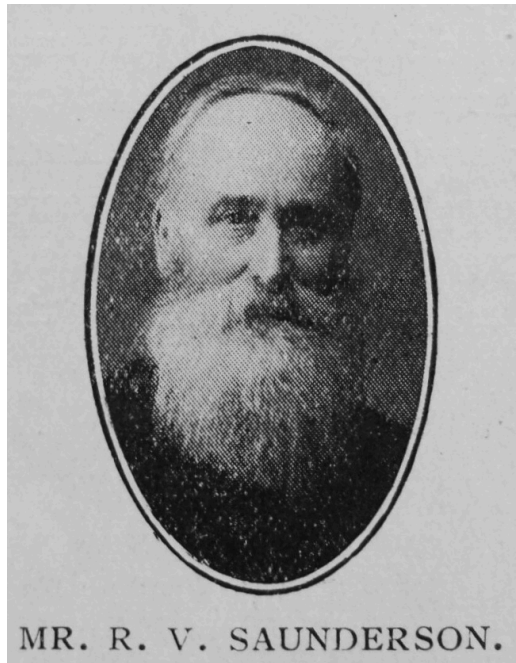
Robert V. Saunderson

Transcription of obituary published in the Primitive Methodist Magazine

A conspicuous figure has been removed from Lincoln Primitive Methodism by the death of Mr. Robert V. Saunderson, which occurred suddenly from heart failure on November 21st.

For many years he had filled the offices of trust treasurer and society steward, and earlier in life was superintendent of the school. For a quarter of a century he discharged the duties of circuit steward with success. At Rasen-lane church he seemed always busy, no task being too menial, no duty too exacting for his devotion. He loved the Church and lived for it. His was the type of quiet, modest piety that impresses men as real Christianity.

A memorial service was conducted by Rev. T. Graham on November 25th. The interment took place at St. Nicholas' Cemetery. He leaves a widow, with whom deep sympathy is felt.
