

## George Henry Sellers

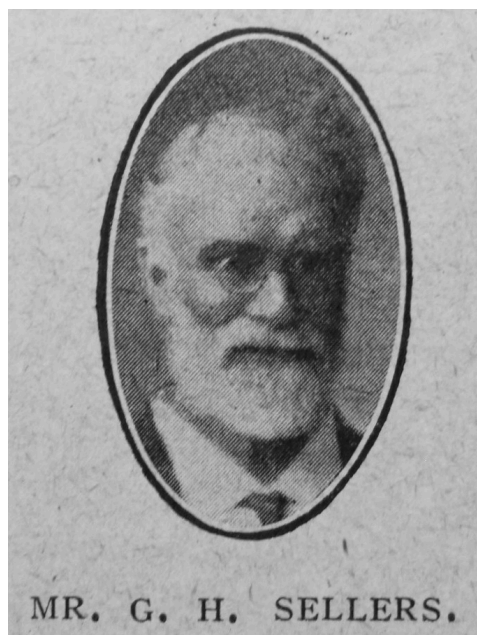
### Transcription of obituary published in the Primitive Methodist Magazine by H.S. Targett

Mr. G.H. Sellers passed to the Homeland from the Bolingbroke Hospital after a brief illness on March 2nd, 1917. He was born at Sheffield in 1850, and was led to Christ at Kilnhurst, in the Rotherham Circuit, in his seventeenth year. In 1869, he was called by the Rotherham Circuit to be a lay preacher, and for forty-eight years his services were freely given.

The insurance company with which he held the position of superintendent, removed him to different towns; thus he was connected at different times with our people in Sheffield, Chesterfield, Hull, Oldham and Wandsworth.

His chief work was in his home, church and circuit. His wise counsel and devoted services will be greatly missed.

He leaves a widow and grown-up family, his only son—the Rev. E. Sellers —being in our ministry.
