
Newrick J. Ditchburn

Transcription of obituary published in the Primitive Methodist Magazine by J. Ramsey

Newrick J. Ditchburn was born, lived and died in the village of Moorsholm, on the Brotton Circuit. Converted in his early manhood, he brought into the Master's service the consecrated energy and strength of his nature. Every office in the local church was held by him at different periods, and held with success. Preaching was his passion, and for thirty-four years, with a powerful, ringing voice, he declared the Evangel in the pulpits and on the village greens of the Guisbro', Brotton and Whitby Circuits.

After an illness of but a few days, he passed away on 5th February, 1917, at the age of sixty-seven. He was interred at Moorsholm Churchyard, after a service in the chapel, conducted by the Rev. J. Ramsay. A large company from all the district gathered at the interment.
