
Simeon Titcombe

Transcription of obituary published in the Primitive Methodist Magazine by E.P.

The Brinkworth Circuit has lost a valuable and highly respected member and official in the person of Mr. Simeon Titcombe, of Purtonstoke, who was a member of the Purtonstoke Church. He was born at Buryhill Farm, Braydon, on March 23rd, 1842, and was converted at an early age. At nineteen years of age he became a member of our Church at Purtonstoke, and for over thirty years was a local preacher, class leader, and society steward, in which capacities he served the Church long and faithfully. He gave most generously to the Church, and did all he could by example and precept to promote peace.

The end came on December 23rd, 1913, in his seventy-first year. His trust in Christ was simply beautiful in the last days of his illness. He was buried on December 27th. The service was conducted by Revs. E.G. French and A. Longstaff. He leaves a widow, three daughters, and one son, who are all members of our Church.
