**Stanghow Community Centre**

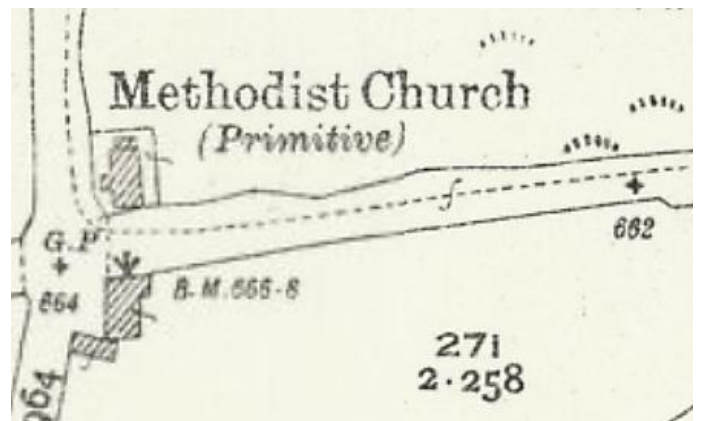
This Hall was originally built in 1910 as a chapel for the residents of Stanghow. Heating was provided in the form of a potbellied stove.
